An alignment with SFDR regulation

On March 10th, 2021, several obligations under the European **Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation (SFDR)** came into force. The SFDR essentially introduces two categories for funds managed with integrated extra-financial criteria: those under **Article 8, addressing environmental and/or social issues**, and those listed under **Article 9, that have set a sustainable development objective**.

This latest progress on the regulatory front pleases us, particularly as it takes place at European level. The SFDR **promotes responsible investment** and advocates **more transparency** and higher standards on **ESG matters**.

Our open-ended funds classified under **Articles 8 and 9** now account for **95% of our assets under management**, reflecting our long-standing commitment and our mission, which is to foster a more durable and inclusive economy.

You will find below the breakdown of our full fund range by category. The funds able to apply ESG integration – but do not meet the standards needed for a classification under Articles 8 or 9 – are listed under Article 6.
